8. The logo should not contain any religious or political symbol.
9. Bring your materials colours, scale, pen, pencil etc.
10. The logo should be artistically balanced.

- Follow all instructions from the invigilator; any malpractice will lead to disqualification.
- **Note:** *In case of a tie, there will be a tie-breaker round with negative marking. For every incorrect answer, 0.5 marks will be deducted. No marks will be deducted for unattempted questions.*
